

Protecting the Past: Towards a better Future with Cultural Heritage

Between the 27th-31st October 2016, the Endangered Archaeology in the Middle East and North Africa (EAMENA) project ran a training workshop and international conference in Sulaimani (Iraqi Kurdistan), in collaboration with the American University of Iraq in Sulaimani (AUIS) and the University of Sulaimani. With support from the Wainwright Fund, we were able to deliver a training workshop involving 18 students and staff members from the two partner universities. The main aim was to introduce trainees to the range of different resources, including satellite imagery, historical aerial photographs and cartographic data, available for heritage research management. The training provided them with an overview and practical experience of how to use these resources.
